While John Philip Sousa is remembered by most as the “March King”, he was also a composer of operettas, songs and other types of music. I've Made My Plans for the Summer was published in 1907 by the John Church Company of Philadelphia, and is the type of song arrangement that was often used by soloists in the Sousa Band as an encore piece. It should be played as a waltz, with rubato introduced at the discretion of the soloist.
