## Ave Verum Corpus

William Byrd

*Arranged by Kenneth Bray*

An organist and choirmaster who was born in England, William Byrd (c. 1543-1623) was a noted choral and harpsichord composer. He is sometimes called the “English Palestrina” (after the famous Italian composer) because of the depth and substance of his sacred compositions.

Ave Verum Corpus is Latin for “Hail, o hail, true body” (referring to the body of Jesus). This text has been set to music by many composers. The piece should be approached with reverence and performed simply, with expression. The performance of choral music in this period is seldom controlled by the bar lines, but rather by the flow of the sacred text.
