## O Vos Omnes

Thomas Luis de Vittoria

Tomas Luis Vittoria (ca 1540-1661) was born in Spain but spent most of his life in Italy. He was a disciple and colleague of Palestrina, one of the most revered composers of liturgical music.

In performance, listen for, and accentuate, rhythmic and tonal imitating passages. Example #1: trumpet 2 and trombone pick up to bar 24; repeated notes are imitated by horn, bar 24 and trumpet 1, trombone and tuba bar 27 with pick ups. Example #2: upward jump of a third in trumpet entry (bar 34 is imitated by a jump of a third and fifth respectively in trumpet 2 and horn bar 34-35, and the trombone follows with a fifth in bar 35).
