Composed during the summer of 1994 and first prize winner at the 1995 University of Laval Festival for Brass Composition Competition, the Three Ludes for Brass Quintet is a collection of short contrasting movements. The Prelude is built around the three-note motive which opens the work. Imitative counterpoint dominates the Interlude while an energetic fanfare launches the Postlude. All dynamic and articulation markings should be exaggerated throughout the Three Ludes.
