Hallelujah, Amen from Judas Maccabeus

George Frederic Handel

THE WORK: In the shadow of the glory of Messiah from the pen George Frederic Handel (1685-1759) came Judas Maccabaeus. This was an oratorio written in 1746, inspired by the English victory at Culloden. This Hallelujah, Amen is not unlike the final piece from Messiah bearing the same name. The instrumentation is similar and the polyphonic writing that is so typically Handel is ever-present.

THE TRANSCRIPTION: The fanfare figures found in the trumpets then later in the horns should not overpower the remainder of the ensemble which is performing the original choir parts. Although a forte dynamic appears often, this should be a Baroque forte and lightness should be present always. To maintain the feeling of lightness, an Eb trumpet could be used on the first trumpet part.
